We are excited to announce enrollment for the **Clinical Homeopathic College Program for 2016-17**.

The Clinical Homeopathic College program is designed to empower new and existing practitioners of many levels of competency who have a theoretical understanding of homeopathy but struggle trying to apply these principals to live case taking. This class is the facilitator for applying good foundational training in a practical and useful way to promote a healthy, effective practice of both classical and clinical homeopathic services. These courses specialize in the reality of real clients, with real problems, who are seeking homeopathic solutions at our doors. Understanding the keys or themes of the case, and then finding the indicated remedy which has the healing affinity for your client (Hahnemann's Organon affirmation #3) is our priority. Complicated issues that follow, including what potency, what dose (repetition), and how to manage the follow-up appointments, are covered in this program. We take live cases, not paper cases! We discuss real issues like sexual abuse, autoimmune malfunctions, and stress management, which results in disease prevention and a higher quality of life for our clients. This program includes guest speakers, tutorial support and technical staff. Increasing your effectiveness as a practitioner is more rewarding for you and increases your referral base, contributing to more success for your community.

Join us for 11 classes a year for this 1, 2, and now 3-year program. We will be using the newer texts/resources and applying them to daily use in this 3 year program including: Rajan Sankaran ("Soul of Remedies" and his many other works), Jan Scholten (Minerals and Elements), Lou Klein (Miasms and Nosodes), Linda Johnston (Everyday Miracles), and Frans Vermulen (Plants and Monera (nosodes)). The motivation for studying the materials from these masters is that they are successful practicing homeopaths. Their material is from experience not just theory. Courses begin 20th January, 2016. Please prepare with the prerequisites of completion (or live attendance) of 5 video classes: Introduction to Homeopathy (Free on website), Family Class 1, 2, and 3 (2 classes: Disease Prevention Tonics and 42 Remedies) \$250.00 for all classes (a \$295.00 value). Both Programs consist of 11 lessons mailed to you in the form of a Flash Drive. The next lesson is with return of previous flash drive. Class viewing, reading and case taking is at your own pace. The intention is to complete one lesson and 5 cases per month. A lesson also includes a monthly 1-hour private phone tutorial with Ellen *that you are responsible to schedule with the administrative office*. Homework and study packets include; reading assignments as well as a selection of live, recorded, and suggested movie cases. The 12th month will be review of cases submitted and a final exam.

Unique to this Clinical College Program is the grand advantage of case taking. Obtaining practical knowledge vs: book learning will enable you to apply your knowledge in practice not just theorize. You will be supplied enough cases to meet your quota with the option of movies from the list provided. You will be expected to submit 5 cases per month for discussion and/or review. The cases can be of observations or interviews of proposed clients, cases including in the lessons provided and/or group cases and movies mentioned above. It is significant to develop good case taking skills by applying your new Repertory and Material Medica texts. The 2ND year provides 11 more advanced lessons and 5 cases per month with follow-ups for crucial case management experiences necessary for a successful practice. This year, by demand, we have added a 3rd ongoing year to our College Program.

I'm excited to have negotiate a book discount for all of you who will need to purchase or supplement your library. These books may be purchased as a new set by contacting Dana Ullman at Homeopathic Educational Services at 510-649-0294, or through his website www.homeopathic.com. (*I have a few selections at the office you might check for first.)

Dana does a lot to support homeopathy and provide the research materials that we will be referring to over the 2-year course. Prices for the books are discounted for this course. Shipping will not exceed \$15. Or, be sure to inquire about 'flat rate' boxes or media rate, which are for books; both are a good deal if you use another source.

Book List Year-1: The focus for Year-1 is understanding homeopathy (theory), its affinity for your client by identifying what, in fact, is the nature and origin of a disorder while embracing the healing quality of the remedies (through the dynamic of proving's and clinically-cured cases). The Clinical College Program requires the following textbook selections.

Year-1 reading assignments will be primarily from the following great books:

- a. Organon of the Medical Art by Samuel Hahnemann and interpreted by Wenda Brewster O'Reilly
The 6th edition of the original Organon is substantially less expensive but a can be a challenge to apply, but that will lead to a great discussion in class!
